12.) Sportsmanship # 2	Review of ROP Section VI Sportsmanship A, B,C, D	All	BOD is encouraging members to review sportsmanship section of Rules of Play. VI. Sportsmanship A. Good sportsmanship should be the prevailing attitude during all CVDA events. B. Attempts to distract an opponent while he is throwing will not be tolerated. Complaints in writing may result in the Execute Board taking disciplinary action. C. All CVDA members should respect the rights of throwers and endeavor to impress upon others the importance of darting etiquette. D. Darts can be deadly. Any member who throws a dart at anyone shall be ejected from the CVDA membership forever. Failure to observe by the outlined rules will result in disciplinary action. Please take the issue of sportsmanship with great consideration.
