Susan called General Membership meeting to order at **7:30pm**

Susan thanked Chester Junction for hosting the meeting.

- Susan called on Secretary Sandra Martin to read May 14th, 2025. General Membership meeting minutes. Motion called for acceptance of minutes, second received, voted on and passed.
- Susan called on Jenn Wicks for the **Treasurer's Report**. For period through 7/12/2025
Total bank account \$63,435.54. General account \$28,259.91. Classic account \$19,181.64.
Classic fundraising \$3,301 - expenses \$4,803.97. (*We raised \$675, which left \$4,128.97 in expenses*)
Sanctioning account \$16,595.96 Singles league account \$245.
Motion was called to accept the Treasurer's Report, motion seconded, voted on & passed.
- Susan called for **League Directors report**; Bobby White welcomed everyone, congratulated winners from last season **Bronze**, HELL NO, **Silver**, Trainwreck, **Gold**, UREDUHM.
 - Singles League winners; Division A, 1st Terry Tucker, 2nd Paul Martin, 3rd Bobby White and 4th Adam Wolcott. Division B, 1st Dee Tucker, 2nd Ashley Morgan. 3rd Sam White and 4th Kendall White. Last season, we had 11 shooters in the singles league. This season, we have 14. Bobby encouraged everybody to shoot at least one time in the singles league just to see how it is.
- Susan called on Chris Wicks for the **Vice President's report**. Working on getting sanctioning of the boards done with Susan and possibly getting someone else if needed. Upcoming tournaments: September 13th (Partners) and 14th (Omega's). Saturday Sept. 27th SCAN (Stop Child Abuse Now) at Murphy's Law [1 dollar of every entry fee goes to Central Richmond SCAN. So, if you can, get out and support these two great events. That's all I've got.
- Susan gave the **President's report**.
 - 1) Thanking the board for their hard work and dedication so far this year.
 - 2) Also thanked Sam White for all her hard work that she did for the Dart Classic and fundraising.
 - 3) Amy Gartrell was thanked for all that she does to keep us straight.

NEW BUSINESS

- Dave Gardner; Motion for GOLD to replace 301 DIDO/Cricket with 501/Cricket. Motion seconded, discussion followed, vote taken and passed.
- Quinny made motion When players that have been added to a team on the original roster or added to a team during the season and if they have not played in CBBA prior to the season and their 0-1 encrypted averages are to be used from any other dark connect combined If the board is unable to locate any errors, then the player would start at a woman 35 and 1 and men 40 and 1.5. Montion seconded, discussion followed, vote taken and passed.
- Chris Lampion's motion to have the points posted every 60 days at a minimum so people that are getting close to certain things might attend more tournaments. Motion was seconded, discussion held, vote taken and not passed.
- Quinny motion is for goal one to play goal one, goal two to play goal two, silver one to play silver one, silver two to play silver two, and bronze to play bronze. Motion seconded, very confusing discussion followed, vote taken and passed.
- Quinny motion, instead of 16 teams come playoffs per division, drop it to eight. The top two teams have byes, everybody else plays each other, until you get to the one and two, and so on and so on. Ashlye Morgan seconded, discussion followed, vote taken and did not pass.
- *(Previous motion redone due to confusion)* Quinny motioned, the playoffs come gold 1, gold 2, silver 1, silver 2, bronze. Paul seconded motion, discussion followed and motion restated "there will be a Gold 1 winner, there will be a Gold 2 winner and a Champion of GOLD overall. There will be a Silver 1 winner, there will be a Silver 2 winner and separate playoffs for Silver 1 and Silver 2". Voted on and passed.
- Paul Martin made motion "to not use stanchions for finals and just use the boards in the box". Motion seconded, discussion followed, motion modified to "purchasing lighting for stanchions", discussed, voted on and passed.
